## GRAND KNIGHT - 45 MINUTES to COR

## **GRAND KNIGHT**

10 Minutes (Estimated) – You must meet with your pastor and seek his permission, reminding him that you don't expect any work from him, only his blessing on this project; certainly, encouraged to attend.

15 Minutes (Estimated) – Review your council membership role and select, then appoint a council Evangelization and Faith Formation (EFF) Leader to oversee the implementation and leadership of Cor.

**20 Minutes (Estimated)** – Meet with the man you have selected to lead the EFF (COR) initiative for you council. Appoint him to take this leadership role. Share materials from <a href="www.kofc.org/cor">www.kofc.org/cor</a> with him for a starting point to begin COR sessions (more information below).

## EVANGELIZATION AND FAITH FORMATION LEADER

**Setup Time, Date & Location** - The EFF leader should establish the logistics outside of the council business meeting for the COR sessions. Preferably these are every month and should be advertised in church bulletins and other medium, inviting all men of the parish, not just brother Knights.

*Order Materials* – Many options are available at <a href="www.kofc.org/COR">www.kofc.org/COR</a> for handouts, booklets and many videos to lead multiple COR sessions. The flexibility is unlimited in what media or content is selected to lead these men thru all three elements of each session to include Prayer, Formation and Fraternity.

*Host the COR Discussions* – Typically, each session is about 45-60 minutes total to include each of the following elements:

Prayer (Example - Rosary, Adoration or a specific Novena), Formation (Example – Knights of Columbus publications, Bible study, Men of The Word, workbook), Fraternity (Example – Grill some burgers, sample bourbons, explore local beers, try new cigars).

**Lead the Discussions** – Encourage participation in each element of the session. Men should be respectful, accountable to each other and most of all - non-judgmental. The relaxed and flexible setting is key to men being open about their faith, feelings and desires to be closer to Jesus Christ. These COR sessions are key to building our personal faith through each other.

**Report** – Submit an on-line report to our supreme council at <a href="www.kofc.org/cor">www.kofc.org/cor</a>. You will find a drop-down menu of "yellow" blocks on the right side of the screen, "COR quarterly summary". Entries are simple and the total time to complete this is about 3 minutes. You can report once per quarter or at the end of each session.
